Title Board Meetings

Public Participation in Board Meetings

The Board recognizes the right of free expression on the part of citizens living in the Merged Area. Persons wishing to address the Board on an agenda item should notify the President's office at least 72 hours prior to the time of the meeting. Persons wishing to present petitions may do so at the agenda time set for Oral Communications. However, the Board will only receive the petition(s) and no action will be taken. The President of the Board may set an appropriate time limit for public participation and discussion.

Persons who have a complaint about employees may bring their complaint to the Board only after they have followed Board Policy addressing citizen's complaints.
